




Out For a Ride, 33 x 49, oil (featured on front and back cover)

Shelby Keefe's love of nature is expressed in the unhurried scenes of rural life, which perhaps stems from growing up on a farm in Wisconsin in a family of artists and crafters. She is particularly deft an her interpretation of architecture; whether it be gritty abandoned factories, small town neighborhoods, or gently declining old farm buildings, she uses unexpected compositions to pull out the nearly forgotten elements in the character of each structure. One of Shelby's signature techniques is to tone her canvas with a range of blues, pinks, reds or oranges which serves to enrich and enliven the finished painting with color surprises and inherent transitions from warm to cool.

With each solo show we encourage the featured artist to invite a fellow painting peer to show with them. Shelby invited the gutsy, direct paintings of Evergreen, Colorado artist, Susiehyer. Friends and collaborators, together these two artists' paintings create a great conversation about dynamic, bold and unexpected approaches to painting.

Shelby's show can be seen at Oh Be Joyful Gallery in Crested Butte, CO from August 22 through September 17 - with her opening reception Friday, August 25, from 5-8pm.


